

Useful Neutralisation

Match the acid with its corresponding alkali in these useful neutralisation reactions.

Acid	Alkali
Plaque acid. 	Jelly fish stings.
Vinegar is often poured onto the skin to neutralise the sting and relieve the pain.	Antacid tablets such as renies or tums neutralise excess stomach acid.
Heartburn.	Toothpaste neutralises acid in the mouth, stopping it from eating away at your teeth and forming cavities.
The pain of this sting can be relived by using pouring vinegar over the skin.	These stings are acid so can bee neutralised with bicarbonate of soda.
Bee stings. 	Wasp stings.
