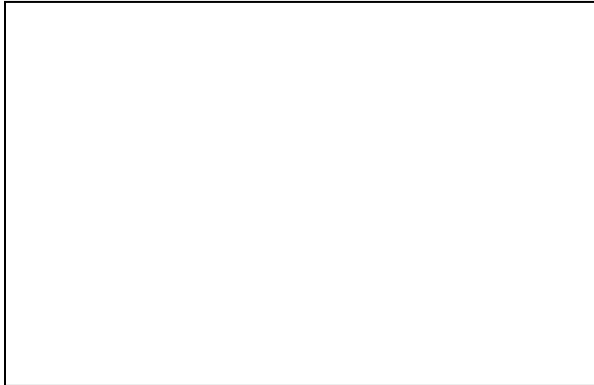
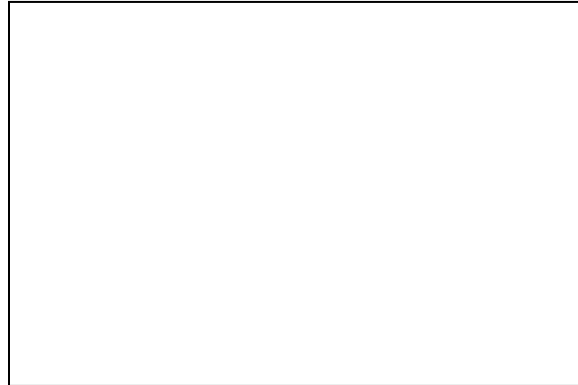


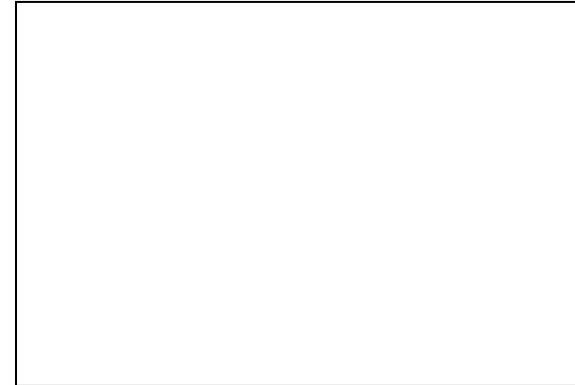
Blood Cartoon



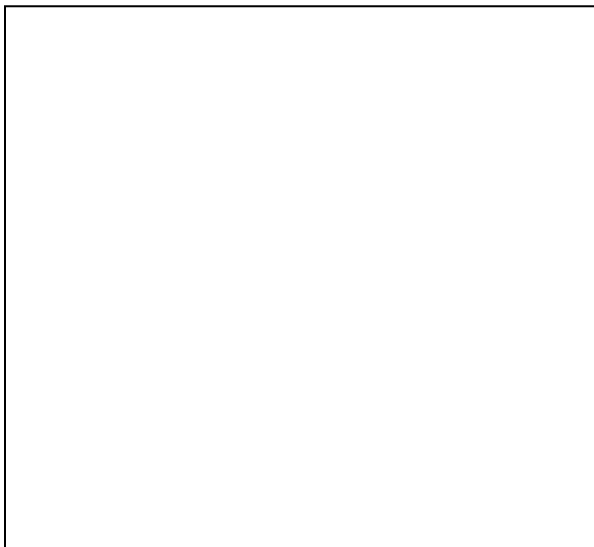
Blood is a mixture of plasma, red blood cells, white blood cells and platelets.



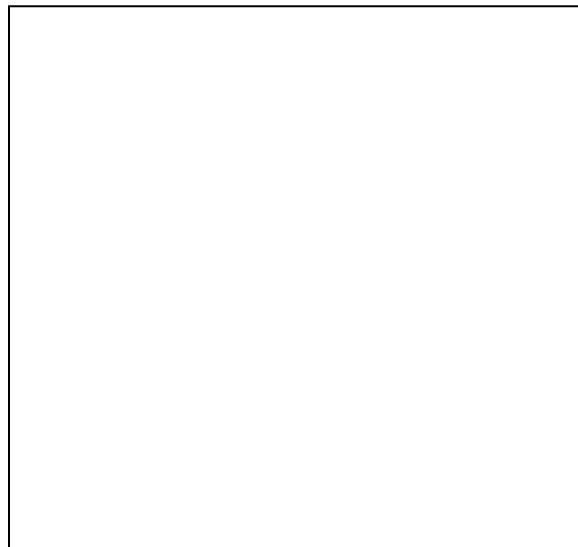
Red blood cells carry oxygen around your body.



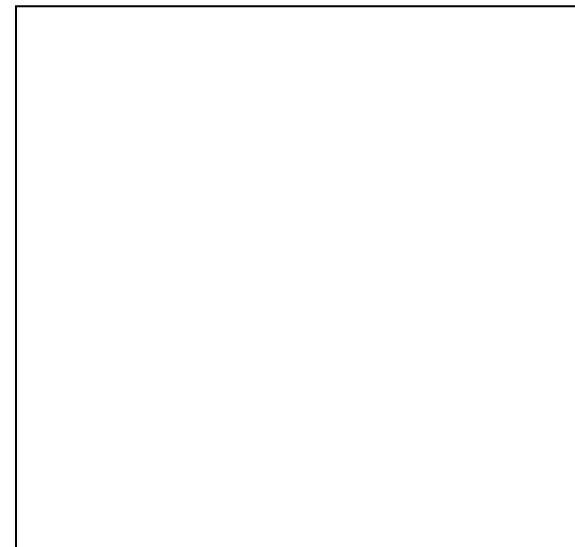
Plasma carries hormones and small soluble substances, such as glucose.



White blood cells called phagocytes 'eat' bacteria.



White blood cells called lymphocytes produce antibodies.



Platelets help the blood to clot (form scabs)
