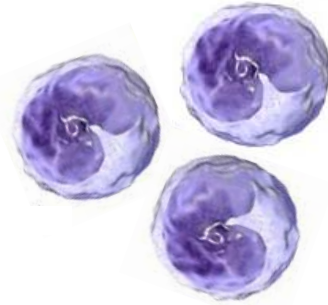


BLOOD



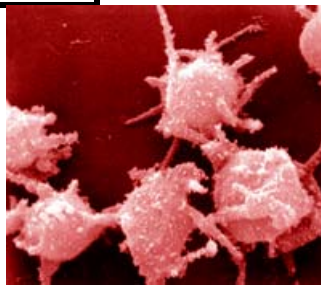
RED BLOOD CELLS

5,000,000 per cubic millimeter
Carry Oxygen & Carbon Dioxide
Made in bone marrow



WHITE BLOOD CELLS

6,000 per cubic millimeter
Destroy Bacteria
Made in lymph nodes

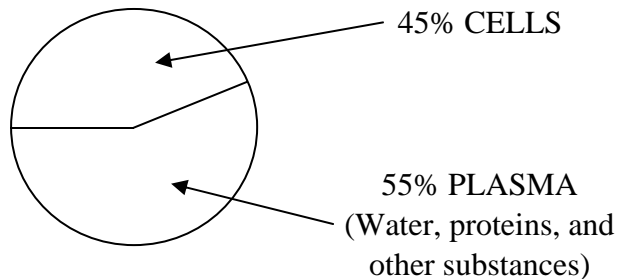


BLOOD PLATELETS

300,000 per cubic millimeter
Help blood clotting
Formed from bone cells in bone marrow

A cubic millimeter is approximately the size of two pin heads
