Q2 Life Processes are the things that both plants and animals do to be classified as being alive. Life Processes which are common to both plants and animals are shown in the table below. Match up the name of the process with its meaning by drawing a line between the two.

<u>Life Process</u>	<u>Meaning</u>
Growth	The ability to produce more of its kind
Nutrition	The ability to move all or part of the organism
Respiration	The increase in size and complexity of an organism
Excretion	The ability of an organism to respond
Movement	The ability to take in oxygen and give out carbon dioxide to make energy
Sensitivity	The removal of waste materials which the cells have made and may be poisonous
Reproduction	The ability to take in food or raw materials to support other life processes
